Theme	Topic	Lesson Information
Bullying & Violence Prevention	<i>Campaign Against Bullying</i>	Lesson Plan <i>Campaign Against Bullying</i> : Students will create a publicity campaign to eliminate bullying.
Attendance & Achievement	<i>Patience</i>	Lesson Plan <i>Patience</i> : students will learn skills using a game to practice patience.
Health & Wellness	<i>Self-Control</i>	Lesson Plan <i>Self-Control</i> : Students will practice the art of self-control with an on your feet activity.
	<i>Mental Health</i>	Lesson Plan <i>Respect</i> : Sara and Gema share their story of wellness which can be adapted to discuss mental health issues and the importance of belonging and agency.
	<i>Drug and Alcohol Prevention</i>	Lesson Plan <i>Warning Signs</i> : Students learn about the dangers of tobacco use.
	<i>Sexual Abuse</i>	Lesson Plan <i>If It Feels Ewwy</i> : Students discuss what to do in concerning situations which can be adapted to issues of abuse.
	<i>Teen Pregnancy Prevention</i>	Lesson Plan <i>Making Health Choices</i> : Students learn about making choices in this activity which can be adapted beyond alcohol and drug use.
